

#### Dear Friends in Christ:

We all live by the calendar year, which consists of 12 months. Christians live also by the church year calendar. As we enter into the final month of 2022 we also are ushered into a new church year as well. In fact the new church year began with Sunday November 27, 2022.

The church year has basically two halves to it. We call them the festival half and the year of the church. With Christ the King Sunday on November 20, 2022 we completed both the church year and the second half of the church calendar and now we embark on the festival half of a new year. It begins with Advent and ends with the Day of Pentecost. The chart above indicates how we live in two years as Christians. The four seasons at the center of the chart reflect

the calendar year and the outside circle the church year. The festival half which begins in Advent focuses on the life of Christ and the remainder on the life of the church.

ADVENT is a season of longing and anticipation during which we prepare for the coming of Jesus. While Christmas themes abound in stores, with the playing of carols and holiday music we cannot jump past Advent. The color of Advent is blue, a symbol of waiting and hope.

CHRISTMAS is both a day and season, 12 days, when we celebrate God's coming among us. The fulfillment of Emmanuel, God with us, is symbolized by white, reminding us of Jesus, who is the light of the world.
